









INVITATION TO TENDER

Suitably qualified, experienced and fully registered **Citizen Owned Entities (More than 50% Citizen Ownership)** are hereby invited to tender for the following services to Debswana Diamond Company (Pty) Ltd at Orapa Mines:

RFP Doc753676826 - DISMANTLING OF OLD LETLHAKANE MINE PLANT AND FUEL TANKS AT LETLHAKANE MINE

Brief

The scope of works comprises of the dismantling of the Old Letlhakane Mine Plant and Old Letlhakane Mine Fuel Storage Tanks, and will involve demolition works as well as the provision of temporary support to ensure Safe Dismantling. The works involve the stripping and stacking of various electrical and mechanical components, followed by the bringing down of the Steel Structures and demolition of Concrete Slabs, Plinths and Footings. The undertaking involves the safe disposal of waste generated from the works and rehabilitation of the old plant area, once dismantled. Tenderers are advised to note that there are preparatory works requirements (prepare laydown areas for stacking of various components as dismantled from the plant, as well as re-routing of existing services to isolate the plant without affecting any on-going operations before the Dismantling can commence).

Contractors shall be expected to conform to all applicable laws and guidelines regarding the services as well as conformance to Debswana standards and procedures including COVID-19 regulations.

Tender Pre-requisites

Prospective tenderers should meet ALL the minimum requirements as requested in the table below, to be legible to tender for the works

1	Experience	The bidder to have over 5 years' experience working in Process Plant Construction or demolition projects (Bidder will be expected to provide traceable references and profile of nature of works) at the time of tender submission
2	Commercial aptitude experience	The bidder to have successfully managed and delivered various (Minimum three projects, one of which should be in a mining environment) Individual projects of similar nature in excess of BWP 30 Million (Bidder will be expected to submit details of similar projects (plant dismantling works, plant construction etc.) completed in excess of P30m and reference contact details of respective clients) at the time of tender submission.
3	Commercial astuteness	Bidder will be expected to submit Audited Financials for the past three years (Statements to demonstrate bidder's ability to manage high value projects) at the time of tender submission.
4	Organisational Capacity	 a. The bidder should Demonstrate 100% ownership or ability to acquire or access to the Proposed Equipment to be used on the project (attach list with copies of valid Registration books and intent to lease/Leases agreement where leased). b. Bidder will be expected to submit ECOHS performance records for a Minimum of three relevant projects with any supporting documents that are available (attach SHE records/statistics on previous projects and reference contact details of respective clients) at the time of tender submission.
5	Commercial readiness	Bidder will be expected to submit letter of intent from pro- posed Performance Bond insurer/Guarantor (not less than 50 million) at the time of tender submission.

Compulsory Site Visit

Tenderers are required to attend a Compulsory Physical site visit in order to familiarize themselves with the site, the scope of works and the conditions under which the works are to be executed.

Prior to the Physical Site Visit, a Virtual Microsoft Teams Meeting will be held on **Friday 8th October 2021 at 10:00 hrs.** This is to align on the scope of the undertaking and minimise time on site as well as enable potential bidders to compile list of questions, to be addressed on site. **The Bidder will also be inducted on Social Way Framework.**

Owing to the on-going COVID-19 pandemic, the Pre-Bid Meeting will be conducted in **two (2) days** to be able to manage the allowable numbers for gatherings. The physical site visit will be held on **Tuesday 12th October at 0800hrs** and on **Wednesday 13th October 2021 at 08:00hrs.** Tenderers are to meet **Mr. Harkirat Singh Gill** at **0730hrs, Tlou Boardroom, Technical Block, Orapa.** Tenderers are required to arrange their own transport and accommodation (if required). Tenderers are further expected to bring Personal Protective Equipment (Reflective overalls (Orange reflective Strips), Laced Safety boots and hard

hats with chin straps, Gloves and safety googles at a minimum). The Site Visit Agenda will start with an ECOHS and Security Induction at 0800Hrs at Tlou Boardroom before proceeding to the Site at Letlhakane Mine.

Access Permits into The Lease Area

Before the tenderer's representatives will be allowed on site, they will have to be security cleared at least 48hrs before the site visit date. **Persons who have not been security cleared shall not be allowed to enter the company's security areas**. To be able to enter the Site, the the tenderer's representatives must bring along a Covid19 negative test result that is less than 72 hours old and will need to be vetted by the Orapa Mine Hospital. A medical fitness declaration for a day's exemption will need to be filled in.
