TENDER NO 003/01/2022; PROVISION OF SECURITY SERVICES TO BOTSWANA MEAT COMMISSION (BMC) IN LOBATSE, FRANCISTOWN AND MAUN ON A TWO (2) YEAR CONTRACT FROM 2022 TO 2024

The Botswana Meat Commission invites licenced 100% citizen-owned security services companies who are fully registered with the Public Procurement and Asset Disposal Board under PPADB Code 100 (Security Services) Subcode 01 (Guard Services) to bid for the tender for Provision of Security Services to BMC plants in Lobatse, Francistown and Maun.

The detailed tender document can be collected from the Purchasing & Supplies Manager's office upon presentation of proof of payment of a **P2500.00** non-refundable tender collection fee, payable by cash at the cashier's office at BMC-Lobatse head office, commencing **Tuesday January 18, 2022** during working hours (**0730hrs -1300hrs and 1400hrs – 1630hrs**).

Compulsory site visits are scheduled for **Tuesday, January 25,2022 (Lobatse), Thursday, January 27,2022 (Francistown) and Friday, January 28,2022 (Maun)** commencing at 1000hrs at all sites. Attendants must observe Covid-19 protocols at all times during the site visits.

Only one(1) representative of each bidding company is allowed to attend each site visit. Failure to attend any of the compulsory site visits will lead to disqualification.

The **closing date for the submission of completed tender documents is on Tuesday, February 08, 2022 at 1000hrs**. Sealed tender documents are to be registered and deposited in the BMC Tender Box at the **BMC Lobatse Head Office reception** not later than the above closing date and time. Late submissions will not be accepted.

A limited attendance tender opening will be conducted immediately after tender closing, with a limited number of attendants permitted in accordance with Covid-19 protocols and tender opening results availed to all tender participants immediately thereafter.
